Equitable Stroke Control (ESC)

The USGA established **ESC** to set the maximum score that a golfer can post on a hole for handicap purposes. When entering your score in the GHIN system, you must reduce your score if you exceeded the maximum ESC for your handicap on any hole. Maximum score if your handicap is:

9 or less = **double bogie**; 10 thru 19 = **7**;
20 thru 29 = **8**; 30 thru 39 = **9**.

Please reduce your total score by any amount over these values.
