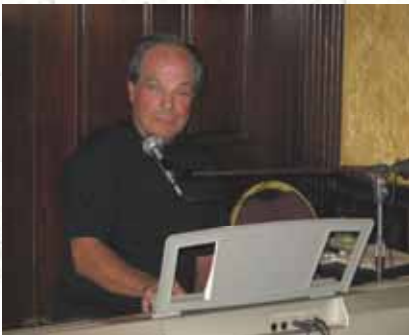


Labor Day Scramble Special

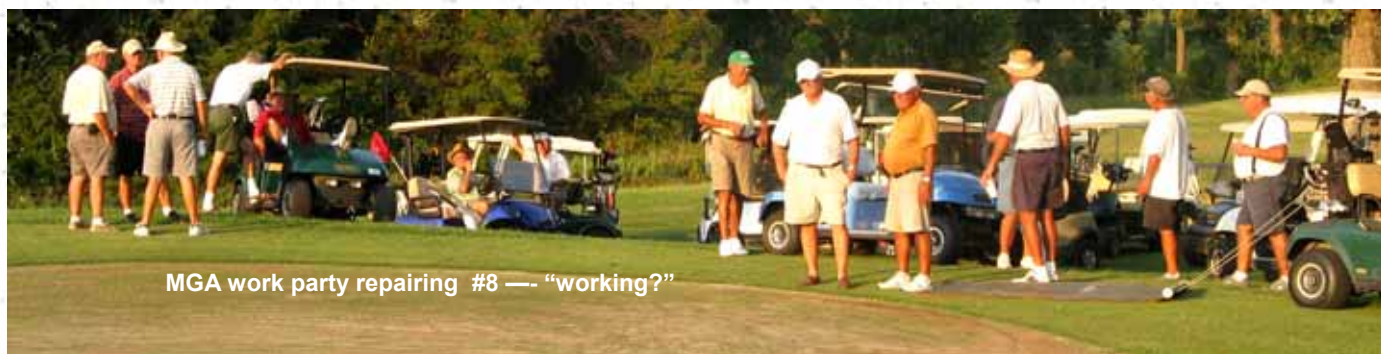

July was especially wet causing rapid growth of grass and deep roughs. Limited working machinery delayed proper mowing but we're catching up. August was extremely hot and caused extensive damage to our greens. We've recently had some cooler weather and are now working to aerate and re-seed some greens. If the weather cooperates, we should have the greens back to their normal condition very soon. We're anticipating additions to our turf staff to help in maintaining our equipment and getting our course in top shape. Our fine bent-grass greens have suffered in the extreme summer heat.
